





POLICY LETTER 01-07

To: The Marines and Sailors of CBIRF
Subj: BOAT PARKING IN BARRACKS 1752 PARKING LOT
Encl: (1) Boat Space Placard

1. All Marines and Sailors at Chemical Biological Incident Response Force (CBIRF) who own boats, trailers, and or any other equipment stored in the 1752 Parking Lot, there will be a standardized placard provided to you from your company office. This placard will allow any duty walking his or her post to identify whom the boat or trailer belongs to.
2. All boats and trailers will be parked on the side closest to the Noncommissioned Officer/Staff Noncommissioned Officer parking lots. There will be 12 spaces reserved for boats and trailers only.
3. No vehicles will be parked in these spots and no vehicles will be left attached to the trailers. If your vehicle is found this way, you will be reported to your company office by the duty Officer of the day.
4. All Marines and Sailors will turn a copy of the placard in to their respective company, and keep a copy on the boat and/or trailer.
5. Inoperable boats and trailers are not to be stored on parking lot.
6. Maintenance is not to occur in parking lot.
7. All boats and trailers will be kept in proper working order.
