Subj: ASSIGNMENT OF OPERATORS IN THE PERFORMANCE OF 1ST ECHELON PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE

1. Purpose. To ensure operators are assigned to the Battalion's equipment requiring licensed operators in order to perform preventive maintenance, checks, and services (PMCS) and first echelon maintenance.

2. Cancellation. This letter will remain in effect until revision or when indicated by appropriate authority.

3. Information. The commodity OIC's are responsible for ensuring assigned personnel complete the appropriate first echelon maintenance under supervision of maintenance personnel.

4. Scope. This policy pertains to all military personnel assigned to Chemical Biological Incident Response Force.
