Subj: QUALITY CONTROL



1. Purpose. Quality Control (QC) is one of the most important functions of Maintenance Management. QC seeks to detect improper Corrective Maintenance (CM) procedures at the commodity/shop level. The senior SNCO of each commodity will verify that all operators and mechanics are properly supervised and trained in conducting QC.

2. Cancellation. This letter will remain in effect until revision or when indicated by appropriate authority.

3. Information. Commodities will assign, in writing, one QC SNCO/NCO per shop section. Per reference (a), desktop procedures will be established and maintained by the QC SNCO/NCO. All QC paperwork will be filed in the appropriate equipment record jacket and maintained for one year in order to ensure maintenance is properly performed

4. Scope. This policy pertains to all military personnel assigned to Chemical Biological Incident Response Force.
