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

Subj: ANNUAL REVIEW OF TEST, MEASUREMENT AND DIAGNOSTIC EQUIPMENT
(TMDE) AND CALIBRATIONS

1. Purpose. To publish guidance regarding the annual TMDE review.
2. Cancellation. This letter will remain in effect until revision or when indicated by appropriate authority.
3. Information. Annually, CBIRF validates all TMDE per the references in order to ensure all applicable material is in the correct calibration category.
 - a. Commodities will validate all TMDE during the first quarter of each Fiscal Year. Care must be taken to include all TMDE that may be components of sets, chest or kits (torque wrenches, pressure gauges, micrometers, etc.) in addition to T/E items. Additionally, TMDE designated as "Calibration Not Required" or "Inactive" will have their status reviewed and validated at this time.
 - b. Provides guidance to determine which items of equipment in the inventory require calibration. Also, an operational test code (OTC) of "3" in position 6 of the service/agency (S/A) Management data element of FEDLOG indicates that the item requires calibration.
4. Scope. This policy pertains to all military personnel assigned to Chemical Biological Incident Response Force.
